Phone Expectations

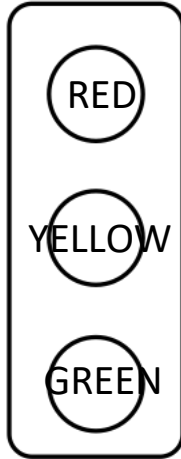
Red: Nope... Park it!

Start on Time & Class Dojo

I value time in class with students. I will begin class on time. There is currently 5 minutes passing time between classes, it is expected that ALL students will arrive to class on time. Any student who arrives after the bell without a pass from another teacher will be marked late. If tardiness is an issue, I will call home and inform your parent/guardian of the situation.

If you arrive after the bell, please quietly and calmly go to your seat, take out your supplies for the start of class, and get right to work. Please do not interrupt class by making a scene when you arrive. If there is something we need to talk about individually, we will find time during or after the period to speak.

Students show improved grades with increased "time on task." I will allow up to 5 hall passes per quarter. Any student with passes remaining at the end of each quarter will earn 1 bonus point to a test equal to the number of times less than 5 that the student has remaining. Budget your hall passes wisely! I reserve the right to deny or delay a student's use of their hall pass at any time.

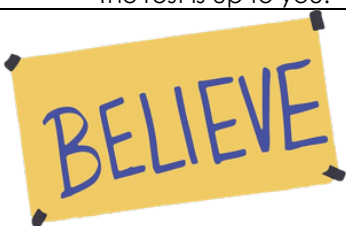
Responsibility and Accountability
